



## Your DIY Vinyl Application Guide

### Before You Start:

Our decals are sent line-by-line to give you complete control over your layout. Take your time—this ensures a perfectly level finish on your mirrors or acrylic signs.

1. Prepare the Surface: Clean your mirror or acrylic with a lint-free cloth and glass cleaner. It must be 100% dry and free of oils.
2. Map it Out: Use low-tack masking tape to create a "baseline" for each line of text. This helps you space the words exactly how you want them.
3. Prep the Decal: Lay the decal on a flat surface. Firmly rub (burnish) over the clear transfer tape with a credit card to ensure the vinyl is stuck to it.
4. The Peel: Flip it over and slowly peel the white backing paper away at a sharp angle. If any vinyl sticks to the paper, rub it again and re-peel.
5. Apply & Reveal: Position your line and press from the centre outwards to avoid bubbles. Once firm, slowly peel the clear tape back at a 45-degree angle.

**Pro Tip:** If you're working with a very large surface, try the "Hinge Method"—tape the top of the decal in place, then flip it up to remove the backing so it stays perfectly aligned.
